




NEW LOCATION: North of Current Location, Across the Street in Stanton Area Industrial Foundation Park





NEW LOCATION: North of Current Location, Across the Street in Stanton Area Industrial Foundation Park






#### **IOWA**

- 75% of lowa households with children under the age of 6 have all parents working outside the home
- 527,194 children ages 0-12 in the State of Iowa
- 167,817 childcare spaces available
- · Shortfall of 359,377 spaces
- On average, 1 in 2 children go without access to affordable quality childcare
- Iowa has lost 40% of its childcare businesses over the past 5 years





## MONTGOMERY COUNTY

483 childcare spaces available
