Stanton Community Garden: 2024 Gardeners Agreement

The Stanton Community Garden is located on the north side of the Stanton Fire Station. This is a public place and with that; we require all renters to read, sign, and abide by the below rules.

- Plots are available for rent at \$15/plot (pay through Viking Center)
- Plots shall be regularly maintained keeping all weeds to a minimum and all plants inside the bounds of your plot
- Anything hazardous to other gardeners or visitors (stray tomato cages, for example) should be promptly removed
- Gardeners should plan to use your own tools, compost, and mulch if needed
- Water will be provided by the City of Stanton Hoses should be rolled up and put away after each use
- Payment for your plot must be made in full and your signed agreement turned in before commencing any work at your plot
- Plots will be assigned on a first come first serve basis
- Raised bed plots are 4'x8'
- Garden plots will be available to use starting during the month of March (plant at your discretion)
- The use of liquid herbicides or fungicides is prohibited
- Japanese beetle deterrents are prohibited inside of the garden
- Children are welcome at the community garden but should be supervised by an adult at all times
- Only annual plants shall be planted in the rental plots
- There is no electricity available at the garden
- All plots must by cleaned out by October 11, 2024: this includes ALL plant debris and trellises
